1986 onwards

I have been a freelance Corporate & Television Cameraman since 1986. Broadcast credits include The One Show, Country File, Newsnight, Grandstand, Scrapheap Challenge, The Big Breakfast, local TV news and Sky News. Corporate work includes numerous medical operations and helicopter work.

1998

I spent one year in the studio with Meridian Broadcasting: Camera Operator on live shows mostly for Channel 5. These included children's shows such as The Mag (live handheld camera for 2½ hrs) & Turnstile (live for 2 hrs mixture of hand held and pedestal cameras).

1999 to 2003

I completed seven series of City Hospital, a live OB for BBC 1 daytime from Southampton General Hospital. At times, I was Senior Camera on this show, all handheld with autocue.

'A Weekend's Work'. A surprise DIY show presented by Yvette Fielding for Meridian, 3 series, often 2 camera shot 'as live'. I was mostly Senior Camera on the shoots.

Most recent live TV work has been the Goal Rush for ITV 1 & 2.

2003-2008

The last few years I have concentrated on shooting and producing corporate and promotional films for the Forestry Commission, the UK MOD, Shipbuilding firms and two major Water Utility Companies. These include a 3D animated film with Richard Briers, which won a silver prize in the Education Category of the 2006 IVCA Awards.

I have also made several small sell through DVDs on subjects such as the Brecon Beacons National Park, Badger Watching and the Reservoirs of the Elan Valley in mid Wales.

Having edited a lot of my own footage I pride myself on being able to provide Producers and Directors with constructive suggestions to improve footage and sequences.

Recent highlights include three four minute packages for BBC1's The One Show.

I also recently coordinated five camera teams, two locked off cameras and four CCTV cameras, on a major exercise involving all three emergency services and totaling 450 personnel.
